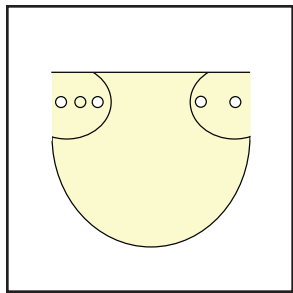


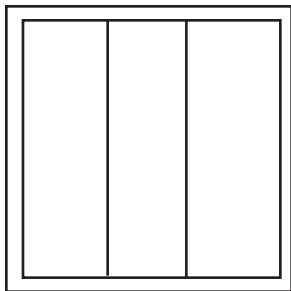
{ a cloth diapering overview }

diapers



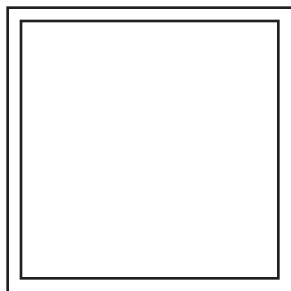
fitted diaper

can be made of cotton sherpa, hemp, flannel, bamboo and other organic materials. has snaps or velcro-type material for closures



prefold

preemie, infant, regular, premium & toddler sizes

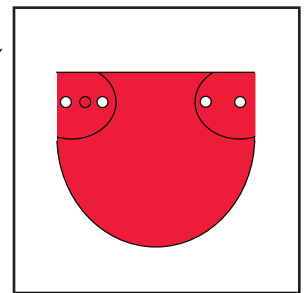


flatfold

can be made of any absorbent material. cut large enough to be folded into different shapes

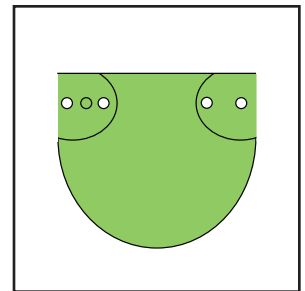
covers

PUL/nylon cover

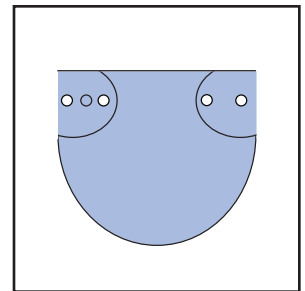


wool cover

interlock, jersey, knitted, crocheted, flannel

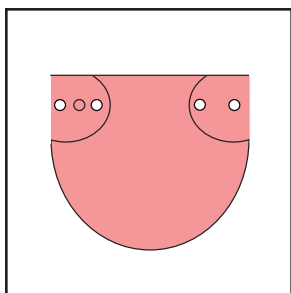


fleece cover



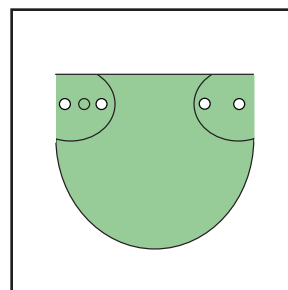
these need a cover!

all in one {AIO}

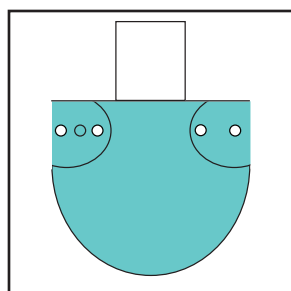
absorbent part of the diaper is built into the cover. closest thing to a disposable.



quick dry all in one

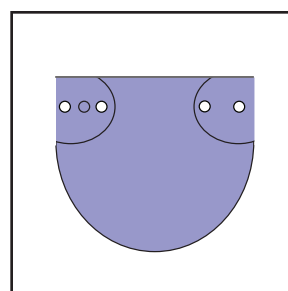
{QDAIO}

diaper is a shell of waterproof material and microfleece. an absorbent soaker snaps into the shell.



pocket diaper

a waterproof layer is lined with a wicking layer like microfleece. this must be stuffed with an absorbent insert.



all in two {AII}

a cover that has a removable diaper. the diaper doesn't have wings, like a fitted.
